

Cornish style houses get Celuform treatment



An ongoing project to refurbish Cornish style houses in south Wales feature Celuform low maintenance fascia and soffit.

Ninety dwellings at Gorseinon, near Swansea have had ageing timber rooflines replaced with Celuform PVC-ue products.
