Duoliner features DuoShield, a co-extrusion process unique to Celuform that provides unrivalled rigidity and durability. Despite being only 8mm thick, Duoliner is the optimum strength/

thickness ratio for a PVC-ue board and has a co-extruded finish both front and rear. In common with other Celuform roofline and cladding products, it is guaranteed for 15 years against rot, fading or yellowing.

One of the best selling external fascias is Conquest Torus, a board with an ogee feature to add interest to the roofline. It also incorporates a groove that will accept horizontal or inclined soffit boards. Rainwater systems can be fixed directly to the fascia without needing additional support. It is available in widths ranging from 150mm to 400mm.

Celuform has one of the largest selections of PVC-ue fascias and soffits, as well as skirtings, windowboards and trims, many of which are available in a wide selection of thicknesses, widths, finishes and colours.
